Factional Enmity



Religion could have been written, scrolled and kept for observance over a period of time or religion can be written, adopted and adapted. The spiritual and psychological lure of it is in its correctness. The measure of its correctness is in its precision. This precision, indirectly or otherwise inevitably invites factional tension.

What I mean by factional enmity here is primarily established rather than experiential or established then experiential. That is, the implicative relativity between "established" and "experiential" is never bidirectional. Either there is no causation or there is no direct relativity between the effect and whatever the cause may be. Something mainly established in this case has no causation for the effect.
